

Competitor Instructions for Marshalling Before Course Closure and at the Start and Finish

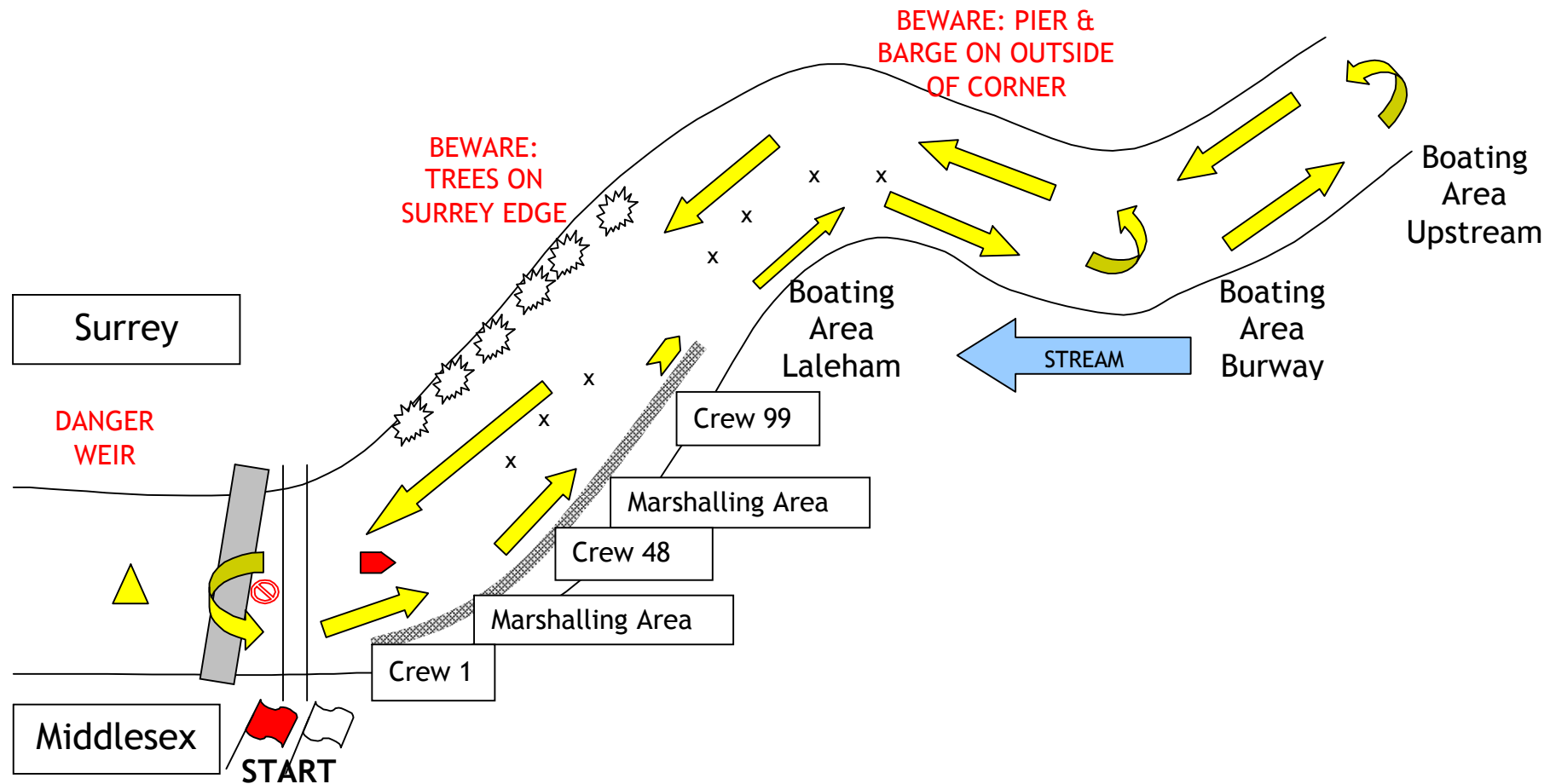
In the lead up to the Race:

Racing boats will observe normal river navigation; that is: paddle off up stream and turn onto the course, (Surrey bank), paddle down to the start and then turn into the marshalling area (Middlesex bank) and line up in crew order with bows up stream.

Prior to the start

The Course will be closed ten minutes before the start of each division. Crews not in position at this time will be instructed to paddle down the navigation channel & join the end of the division, in the marshalling area, racing off last.

N.B. Pleasure craft will be directed into the navigation channel, which is the Middlesex side / half of the river

On the instruction of the Start Marshall, crews will then spin round, paddle down stream and turn around the marker buoy below the start and then proceed to the start. Timing will start a few strokes after the Marshall shouts "Crew No##, GO!"

N.B. Pleasure craft will be directed into the navigation channel, which is the Middlesex side / half of the river
